



**Antonio Gomes** is Acting Deputy Director of the OECD Directorate for Financial and Enterprise Affairs since September 2018. He is responsible for the Directorate's Market Cluster including Competition, Investment, Financial Markets, Financial Education and Consumer Protection, Pensions, Insurance and Public Debt Management, supporting the coordination and management of the policy and standard-setting work in these areas.
